For DVD-10: Printing occurs on top of the polycarbonate. Both sides of the disc must be printed. The print and the data must be on opposite sides of the disc (i.e. if the data side of A is facing down, side A is printed on top). Print appears directly over and only in the matrix area. Full coverage of image area is required to achieve acceptable appearance.

The shaded portion of this diagram indicates the maximum allowable print area. The position of keylines (black circles which outline shaded areas) and registration marks (without dimension information) on this sheet follow the recommended configuration for submitted label film and/or artwork for printing. Keylines should not appear on final artwork and/or film, as they are not in the print area. Registration marks should be 3.5" from center and 90 degrees opposed. All E-files should be clearly identified with your project catalog or reference number, desired print order and film color.
